All the staffs and managers help students to learn English in an effective and conducive way.


PILA's new building was completed last September 2017.

- > Double check your passport and round trip ticket before you board / When passing the immigration screening, you should answer kindly.
- > During the school orientation, students must sign the school policy regulation agreement.
- ▶ Teachers will be assigned based on the entrance and level test,
- > Able to change text-book(no scribbling) or teacher only after the very first week of the school. (Adjustment Period)
- **Failure to make payment before 4weeks students coming, can not be protected by Refund policy.**
